

Criteria for award of Honorary Life Membership of Alnwick Tennis Club

The management Committee (MC) of Alnwick Tennis Club (ATC) may consider the award of Honorary Life Membership of the club in accordance with the following procedure.

Eligibility and Process for Nomination and Award of Honorary Life Membership

Anyone who has been a member of the club for a prolonged period, normally a minimum of 25 years, may be nominated. If that basic eligibility criterion is met, the decision of the MC will be made based on careful evaluation of the contributions of the individual to the club during their membership.

Award of Honorary Life Membership will be made if the nominee is judged by the MC to have made exceptional contributions and/or given exceptional service to the club over a prolonged period.

A nomination, supported by at least two current adult members of the club should be sent in writing to the Secretary of ATC. The nomination should set out the supporting reasons for the nomination focusing on the contributions of the nominee to the club over a prolonged period. Nominators are advised to present a comprehensive overview of the nominee's contributions.

Nominations may be submitted at any time. A nomination will be considered, and a decision made, within 4 months of receipt of the nomination, normally at the next scheduled MC meeting.

The decision of the MC will be final, without the possibility of appeal. However, a re-nomination of an individual may be considered after an elapsed period of at least 3 years if there is new information to be considered.
